## **Trenton Mayor Eric Jackson Announces Appointments to Landmarks Commission, Trenton School Board, and Capital City Redevelopment Corporation**

TRENTON, N.J. — Mayor Eric E. Jackson today made the following appointments:

- **Trevor Kacedon** to a Class A, four-year term on the **Landmarks Commission**. Mr. Kacedon is Global Innovation Project Manager at Godiva Chocolatier in New York, a private-industry role he has held since August 2015. Prior to that, he has worked at iMedGlobal Corporation, a subsidiary of Johnson & Johnson; Bristol-Myers Squibb; CITGO; UT Health; and U.S. Expeditors. Mr. Kacedon has an MBA in project management from Norwich University and a bachelor's degree in business administration and marketing from Berkeley College.
- **Yolanda Marrero-Lopez** to a three-year term on the **Trenton Board of Education**. Mrs. Marrero-Lopez has been a faith leader for three decades at the Church of God, where she is co-pastor. She also taught Spanish at the high school level. Mrs. Marrero-Lopez has a B.A. in biblical interpretation from Pentecostal Bible College in Puerto Rico.
- **Manuel Segura** to a four-year term on the board of the **Capital City Redevelopment Corporation** (CCRC). A former Trenton city councilman (2002-2010), Mr. Segura is president of the Latino Merchants Association of New Jersey. From 2000 to 2006, he served on the New Jersey Civil Rights Commission, and was a member of the Trenton School Board from 1999 to 2002. From 1981 to 1983, he was Director of Hispanic Affairs at the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs. Mr. Segura has a B.S. in public administration from Trenton State College.
